<b>Annual Staffing Surveys for FY 2025</b>	Twenty CSBs have now reported their FY 25 staffing turnover data and the Committee reviewed trends in staffing turnover from FY 2018 to FY 2025. The Committee also reviewed a new presentation of the numbers of staff in different categories employed by CSBs in FY 2025 (staffing profile). <b>State Health Benefit Plan – funding and costs for CSBs</b>	The CFO Focus Group has been collecting data on the costs to CSBs of participation in the State Health Benefit Plan (SHBP) and the funding received from DBHDD to help pay for that participation. The goal is to determine if CSBs overall receive adequate funding to cover the costs of participation in SHBP, and whether there are differences in the extent to which DBHDD compensates CSBs for the expense of SHBP. So far, fifteen CSBs have provided their data. In a significant update, Lee Pavlik reported that the Governor’s budget now proposes a reduction of 10% of payroll in the employer contribution and that the data collected to date may have to be revisited if that budget proposal is approved. <b>Q2 FY 2026 Finances Report</b>	The Committee reviewed charts of data collected from 17 CSBs which indicated that 4 of the 17 were still reporting negative margins in Q2 FY 2026 despite the recent reimbursement rate increases	Request data from the 5 non-responding CSBs and then prepare trend charts to show the changes in margin and days of cash on hand over successive quarters. <b>Investigating the decline in Adult MH / AD clients served by CSBs</b>	The SPQM User Group met on February 10 and reviewed data in GACSB SPQM and from other sources to investigate factors contributing to an overall decline since FY 2020 in the number of adults provided with mental health and addictive disease services by CSBs. Increasing numbers served by FQHCs and other providers may account for some of the decline. 	<p>conduct, staffing shortages, and limits on the ability of CSBs to pay competitive compensation to clinicians may encourage clients with insurance to seek other providers. Consistent with these suggestions, in our SPQM data the decline in numbers served is greater for clients with health insurance than for those without. Also relevant is the suggestion by several on the Committee that some newer services provided by CSBs such as client led and peer groups may not be captured in SPQM encounter data. Our MTM consultants have also confirmed that a decline in adult MH / AD clients served by CMHCs was not unique to Georgia and could be driven by an increasing national focus on rapid access and brief interventions. These possibilities were consistent with our SPQM data which indicated that the percentage of CSB adult MH / AD clients with 6 or more dates of service had declined since 2020.</p>			
<b>DBHDD requests regarding MHSIP and YSS-F client surveys</b>	<p>GACSB shares BH client survey raw data with DBHDD to reduce duplication of surveys. John Quesenberry has recently requested some changes to the survey questions: Add a question on what kind of services client is currently receiving (MH, SA or both), and a question about the payor for clients' services. John Quesenberry had also shared that each Georgia CCBHC would be required to collect 300 Adult and 300 C&amp;A surveys, and 300 MH and 300 SA surveys.</p>	<b>Resend</b> follow-up email to John Quesenberry asking when the added MH SA question should be implemented (FY 26 or FY 27), and seeking clarification on CCBHC requirements for minimum numbers of surveys	Glyn Thomas	02-20-2025
