	The CSB is Me Campaign Part II- Jesse		
	Hambrick reported the small group continues to		
	meet and discuss the next steps in the campaign		
	efforts. Robyn Garrett reported the group is also		
	discussing the idea of I/DD specific campaign ideas		
	and some I/DD directors will be attending the next		
	meeting to have conversations about the idea.
